## BEAVERMEAD CAMPING & PARKING

Teams have been assigned Camp Sites at the Beavermead Campground (see attached map). When you arrive at the Beavermead Campground, please let the Park Staff at the entrance gate know that you are with the Harvest Tournament.

One person from each campsite must register at the entrance gate. Do not pay since the cost is included in your team registration fees. The person registering at the entrance gate should be the driver of the car that is staying at the campsite for the night.

Only one car may be parked at the campsite as per parks rules. Additional cars must be parked in the parking lot (just a stones throw away) or risk being ticketed by Park Staff.

## TOURNAMENT REGISTRATION

All teams and players must register prior to playing on Saturday morning. Please visit the Camp HQ (located at Campsite #17) upon your arrival to register.

Any outstanding fees are due at registration (e.g. additional players above the base of 15 may register for \$50 each. Non-players who are staying for the weekend pay \$40). We accept cash or cheque, but we prefer cheques if you have them (payable to Peterborough Ultimate League).

Team Waiver Forms must also be signed and submitted at registration. Players must be 18 years or older to play in Harvest. We will provide players with a bracelet (your ticket for the weekend!) and captains will receive a welcome package with additional information. Please wear your bracelet for the weekend.

Camp HQ will be open at the following times for registration:

Friday – 5:00pm to 10:00pm  
Saturday – 7:30am to 8:30am

All teams are expected to be registered by 8:30am on Saturday morning. If you are a player that is arriving outside of these times (e.g. after the tournament play has begun), please visit the Field HQ to register.

## WEATHER

Harvest 2017 will proceed rain or shine (please pray for sunshine!). In the event of lightning, teams should clear the fields immediately and take shelter. Play will only resume once the lightning has passed (e.g. 30/30 rule).

In the event of severe rain or thunderstorms, updates will be given via twitter and text to your team communication number.

## CAMP HQ & FIELD HQ

Tournament Headquarters (HQ) is your source for any information you need (e.g. registration, schedules, results, standings, etc), as well as field food, and good times! HQ will rotate between the Camp and Field.

Camp HQ will be located at Camp Site #17. It will be open on Friday night for registration, Saturday morning for registration and breakfast, and Sunday morning for breakfast.

Field HQ will be located between field 2 and field 5 (see the map at the end of this handbook for reference). It will be open during tournament play throughout the day.

Discs can be purchased at HQ!

## WASHROOMS

Washrooms are located centrally within the Beavermead Campgrounds, as well as at the north end of the Fields (just beyond Field #1). See map for details.

## GARBAGE & RECYCLING

Garbage and recycling containers will be located throughout Beavermead Park and the fields. Please help us keep the fields clean by ensuring that all your bottles, cans, wrappers, peels and cores find their proper home. In addition, captains will be provided with garbage bags and blue bags for recycling please chip in and help keep your campsite clean.





## FOOD & DRINK

**IMPORTANT:** Please bring a cup/bottle, plate/bowl and cutlery to manage food and drinks. These will not be supplied.

**WATER:** Water will be provided regularly at each of the fields throughout the day. Water can also be obtained in the Campgrounds, at the Pavilion, and at the main washrooms at the north end of the fields.

**BREAKFAST & FIELD FOOD:** A light breakfast of coffee, tea, bagels, spreads, and fruit will be available at Camp HQ (Camp Site #17) on Saturday and Sunday morning. Food will later be moved to the Field HQ for access during the day. In addition, Harvest 2017 will be hosting a Pancake Breakfast on Sunday morning to help battle your morning grogginess.

**NIGHT KITCHEN PIZZA:** Our good friends from The Night Kitchen will be on hand with their fancy portable wood stove pizza oven "C'est Chaud". Each team will receive some vouchers for pizza. Your captain will provide your team's pizza order and pick-up time, so check with you captain for details on when/how you get your pies. Additional pizza will be available for purchase throughout the weekend as well.

**ROAM COFFEE BIKE:** Need a little jolt of caffeine to get you rolling for your games this weekend? Well, you are in luck! One of our own PUL Juniors, Isaiah Kightley, has started a very cool coffee bike. You will see Isaiah around on Saturday and Sunday offering up coffee and treats for sale. He is raising funds to support Drew Wilson (a local 19 year old player). Drew has made team Canada u24 this year and is headed to Australia to represent Canada in January 2018.

**HARVEST DINNER:** A buffet style selection of delicious soups will be served with bread at the Pavilion on Saturday evening. You'll need a cup, plate/bowl and cutlery to manage the feast... don't forget them! Refreshments will also be provided.

**THE CABIN:** Additional food and drink will be available for purchase through "The Cabin", which is located near the park entrance along Ashburnham Drive.

## TOURNAMENT PLAY

Please talk to your captain if you have any further questions regarding tournament play listed below:

- 11th Edition Ultimate Rules are in effect, unless otherwise specified or decided by the captains prior to starting the game.
- Games will begin promptly according to the scheduled times (e.g. 9:00 AM start on both Saturday and Sunday). At the scheduled start time of the game, if one team is not ready to play, the other team should take the line and signal readiness. Points will be awarded as per rule VIII A.4.
- There will be a 15 minute break between all games.
- Games to 15 points, win by two. Point cap 17. Hard cap will occur after 75-minutes of play. When the 75-minute Hard Cap is sounded (1 long horn blast), at the conclusion of the current point in progress the game is over and the leading team wins. If the game horn sounds in between points (after a point is scored and before the disc is pulled to begin the next point), the game is over. Please do not start the point. If the score is tied, the game is a tie in round robin play. If tied in playoff game, an extra point must be played. The Championship Game will not be subject to hard cap rule.
- Gender ratio will be 4 males : 3 females
- Teams are each permitted one time-out per half, with one floater time-out. Time outs are 70 seconds.
- Team Time-Outs may not be called in the last 5 minutes of play under the Hard Cap.
- Half-time will be 5 minutes long.
- There are 15 teams. Three pools have been established for Saturday's round robin play (Apples, Beets, and Carrots). Each team will play 4 games on Saturday, playing each team within their pool.
- Sunday's games will be playoff format based on standings of Saturday's games (2pts for W, 1pt for T, 0pt for L). The top 8 teams will fight it out for the Harvest Championship and the lower 7 teams will battle for Braggart's Bushel!!

- The top two teams from each pool will get a bye to the Championship bracket and a quarter-final game on Sunday. Two wild card games will be played on Sunday morning to determine the remaining two teams that will advance to the Championship bracket and quarter-final games.
- The Sunday schedule will be posted at the Harvest Feast and the HQ. Each team will play at least 3 games on Sunday (except for one team, who will play only 2).
- Tie-breaking in the standings will be determined by the following order: 1) win-loss record counting only games between the tied teams, 2) skills competition results, 3) disc flip (if necessary). Point differential does not matter.
- Captains should report final scores after each game. You can do this via Twitter @pulharvest, at Field HQ or text scores to Sarah at 705-308-4861

## SKILLS COMPETITION & TIE BREAKS

For fun and as an entertaining way to break any ties in the standings after Saturday's round robin play, a skills competition will be held on Saturday at 5:00pm at Field #1.

Each tied team will have one representative participate in a Maximum Time Aloft (MTA) skills competition. If a tied team is not present for the skill competition, they will default to the lower rank.

## CHAMPIONSHIP & AWARDS

The Championship Game will be held at 3:00 PM on Sunday on Field # 2. We will have Observers on hand to call the game. Following the game, we will have a short awards ceremony for the Harvest 2017 Champions, the winners of the Braggart's Bushel, and the 2017 Harvest Spirit winners!


